Built Environs Pty Ltd are pleased to offer a reference to Bowhill Engineering for works undertaken in 2002 on both the State Library of South Australia Redevelopment and the Tea Tree Gully Community Library Relocation. On both projects, they were contracted to carry out the fabrication, supply and erection of the Structural Steel.

For the \$40m State Library Redevelopment, a very important and complicated component of the contract was the structural modifications and extensions undertaken to the existing structure, where limited access to various areas of the job required careful planning and complicated rigging. The structural steelwork installation went smoothly and resulted in a quality end product, testimony of careful detailing and planning by Bowhill.

Bowhill completed their works in a timely and professional manner to all areas of the project in spite of difficulties resulting from complicated staging and asbestos removal. They were instrumental in maintaining programme and always met both short and long-term programme requirements.
